



COVID-19 RULES AND CONDITIONS

Burnie City Eisteddfod 2021

The following Covid-19 Conditions must be adhered to in order to comply with Public Health Advice, Government restrictions and/or the requirements of the BAFC. The Burnie City Eisteddfod reserves the right to amend or cancel the event if restrictions change.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. All patrons entering the BAFC venue must check in daily by using the Tas Check in QR code or by providing written details of name and contact on sheet provide at the venue. Students are to be checked in by their teacher, parent or supervisor as one point of contact.
2. All patrons must practise **social distancing** where practical.
3. **AUDIENCE** members who are **12 years and over MUST** wear a **FACE MASK** at all times in both the Theatre and Town Hall auditoriums. Please supply your own mask. (Please be aware that the wearing of face masks may change in June/July)
4. No eating or drinking in the auditoriums (except for water bottles).
5. **Non-performers back stage MUST wear a FACE MASK.**
6. Competitors, teachers, parents or ticket holders are not permitted inside the venue if they are unwell.
7. **Hand sanitiser** stations will be set up at the entrance of the venue, the auditorium and backstage areas for individuals to use when entering or exiting the venue. Hand sanitisers will be provided in the dressing rooms as well.
8. Dressing rooms space will be limited. Dressing room numbers need to be strictly adhered to and will be monitored by the Burnie Eisteddfod organisers.
9. On **INSTRUMENTAL BAND DAYS** you will be allocated a holding room/area for your instruments and for your group to get organised. Please see the front desk on the day for details.
10. **BAND competitors in groups** must enter the stage via back stage to compete and exit stage left to go down the steps under the stage when finished. This is to save the congestion back stage when bands change over.
11. On **CHOIR DAYS** in the Town Hall, school choirs will be allocated times of performance. Each choir will be able to watch some choirs perform but must leave at the end of the allocated time session. Family and friends (12 years and over) who wish to be part of the audience will be allowed to watch the choirs from upstairs in the Town Hall but must wear a MASK if they wish to be in the audience.
12. **GRAND FINAL CONCERT TICKETS (Speech & Drama and Music only)** must be pre-purchased during the eisteddfod as seats will be limited.
13. **SEASON TICKET** holders must pre-purchase a concert ticket (at no cost) if you wish to attend any of the concerts. You must show your concert ticket and season pass to be admitted.
